

### **CORN CASSEROLE**

1 (16 ½ oz.) can cream style corn 1 (11 oz.) can whole kernel corn 1 Tbsp. sugar ½ c. yellow corn meal 2 c. milk 5 Tbsp. Canola oil ¼ c. bell pepper, chopped fine 1 med. Onion, chopped fine 1 pack Ritz crackers, crushed 1 egg, beaten ½ stick margarine

Saute onion & bell pepper in canola oil. Add corn meal, corn & 1 ¾ cups milk. Cook until thick, stirring constantly. Add egg to remaining milk. Mix & add to corn mixture. Stirring constantly until thick. Spray 9x13 casserole dish with Pam, then pour in corn mixture. Melt ½ stick margarine & add crushed crackers. Mix well. Add to top of casserole. Bake at 350″ for 45 minutes.
