



#### **WATERMELON SALAD**

1 (5#) watermelon, cut in pieces

1 sweet onion, chopped ¼ cup red wine vinegar Salt and pepper ½ cup extra virgin olive oil 2 tbsp chopped fresh mint 4 oz crumbled feta cheese
