Members and Friends of Grace Presbyterian Church,

Well, here we are again! In spite of all we've been through together in the past year-and-a-half, our society has not yet worked hard enough to bring the coronavirus COVID-19 under control! Instead, many people's reluctance to get the vaccines and wear face masks have scuttled the best efforts of medical science and care to relieve us of this pernicious threat to everyone's health. Our Governor and your Session have therefore been forced to reimpose the following restrictions for the foreseeable future:

## OUR CHURCH'S COVID RESPONSE

In response to the Governor's reinstatement of the statewide mask mandate, the Session has voted to reinstitute our church's previous mitigation measures. Therefore, effective immediately, we will observe the following:

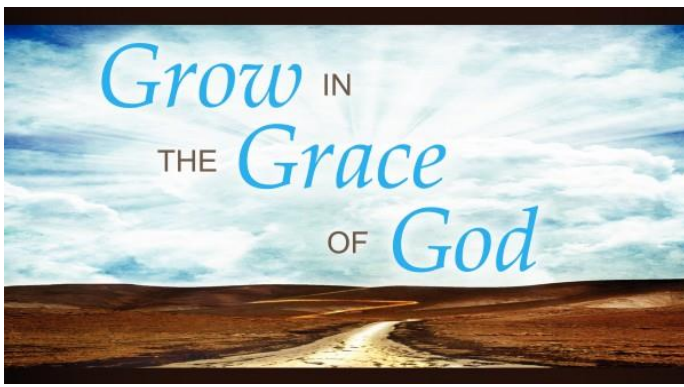
1. All persons, ages 5 and up, whether fully vaccinated or not, will wear a face mask covering their nose and mouth at all times while inside the building with other people. This includes during worship, including while singing, except for our soloist, who has been deemed far enough away from the rest of us to remove his/her mask while singing only. The only other exceptions are the Pastor and any other speakers, while preaching or speaking from the pulpit or lectern. This measure also includes visits to the church office at any time.
2. All persons will maintain social distancing of 6' or more while in the building, including during worship. Worshipers are expected to sit in only every other pew, and to maintain 6' of distance between worshipers, except for members of the same family.
3. All persons entering the building are expected to provide their own masks. A few extras will be available for one-time use, but everyone should come prepared, in order to save the church funds. Sanitary wipes and liquid hand sanitizer will be available in the narthex for worshipers' use.
4. The restrooms will be available and should be used by only one person at a time, except by members of the same family. A sign on the door shall be appropriately turned by all users to indicate whether the room is vacant or occupied.
5. On Sunday mornings, only the front wooden doors will be unlocked for worship in order to prevent extra cleaning of the fellowship hall and kitchen. Exceptions may be arranged for those with disabilities.
6. The Mother's Day Out program will set and maintain their own mitigation measures to suit their use of the building separate from the congregation.
7. Anyone who needs water while at the church is expected to bring their own, as the water cooler is deemed unsanitary for general use, and the kitchen will not be available for general use.
8. During worship we will continue remaining in place and gesturing to one another for the Passing of the Peace.

The Governor's proclamation is effective until September 1, and we will be attentive to his directions again at that time.

I am very sorry that these measures must be taken, but I am thoroughly convinced they must!

As we take this step back, I explicitly invite each of you to call me on my cellphone (**337-781-1806**) without hesitation at any time you have an emergency or just need to talk. In the meantime, I will be praying for each of you and for our community, that this crisis will end soon!

## CHICKEN SPECTACULAR

**3 Cups cooked chicken (cut in bite size pieces)**  
**1 package Uncle Ben's Wild and White rice mix**  
**1 can cream of celery soup**  
**1 medium jar pimentos (optional)**  
**1 medium onion, chopped**  
**2 cups French style string beans (canned)**  
**1 cup mayonnaise**  
**1 can water chestnuts, drained & sliced**  
**Salt & pepper to taste**
